





History of the Swiss Open-Air Museum

- 1945ff: Aktion Bauernhausforschung (farmhouse research, inventory of Swiss farmhouses)
- 1963: The Swiss Federal Council set up an expert commission to consider the possibility of creating a national Open-Air Museum.
- 1968 founding year of the Ballenberg foundation
- 1978: Opening with 16 historical buildings
- 2016: over 100 historical buildings



Number of visitors Ballenberg





Income 2012









Masterplan new permanent exhibition

Masterplan: Its goal is to make the buildings in the Museum intelligible and the current economic system more recognizable.

The houses shall tell their own story.



Masterplan new permanent exhibition

Contents shall be conveyed by telling stories about individuals.



Masterplan new permanent exhibition


- Make clear which epoch, which social class and economic system is being displayed.
- There is one key phrase which describes the message of each house.

- Theme Trails






